#### The median annual salaries of all child care providers in this report are

significantly below the median earnings of persons living and working in each county.¹ While individuals serving in administrative capacities in child care centers are most likely to receive wages above the county's median wage (between \$37,960 and \$38,979 for administrative directors and director/teachers), the majority of child care center teachers (\$27,560) and family child care providers (\$25,869²) are earning well below the median wage for employed persons in their county, with assistant teachers/school-age workers (\$22,880) and child care center school-age assistants (\$20,800) earning the least. When it comes to insurance and pension benefits, about a quarter receive partial or full coverage insurance, nearly 3 in 4 receive pension or retirement benefits, and all staff receive paid sick leave.



#### The Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) reported median

yearly wages for 2020 for four early care and education occupations (Educational Administrators of Preschools/Child Care Programs<sup>5</sup>, Kindergarten Teachers<sup>6</sup>, Preschool Teachers<sup>7</sup>, and Child Care Workers<sup>8</sup>) in all four counties in this report – Boone, Jo Daviess, Stephenson, and Winnebago.

Although the specific occupational definitions differed from IDES descriptions and the *Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey* descriptions, salaries were rather consistent with one another in that wages within IDES's preschool teacher and child care worker categories and the *Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey* child care staff categories were within the same range; however, it should be noted that the IDES's definition of child care worker includes a provider working in either a center or family child care home which is differentiated by the *Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey*.

# KEY POINTS FROM THE ILLINOIS SALARY & STAFFING SURVEY OF LICENSED CHILD CARE FACILITIES: FY 2021

The median full-time, full-year salary of child care staff range from \$20,800 for assistant teachers to \$38,979 for director/teachers.

Teachers, 62.6% of whom have an associate's degree or higher, have a median annual salary of approximately \$26,832.

Half of surveyed family child care practitioners net \$11,000 or less annually.
