#### The median annual salaries of all child care providers in this report are

significantly below the median earnings of persons living and working in each county.¹ While individuals serving in administrative capacities in child care centers are most likely to receive wages above the county's median wage (between \$41,974 and \$48,796 for administrative directors and director/teachers), the majority of child care center teachers (\$32,760) and family child care providers (\$34,999) are earning well below the median wage for employed persons in their county, with child care center school-age assistants (\$24,960) and school-age workers (\$24,440) earning the least. When it comes to insurance and pension benefits, about half receive partial or full coverage insurance, more than half receive pension or retirement benefits, and all staff receive paid sick leave.



#### The Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) reported median

yearly wages for 2022 for four early care and education occupations (Educational Administrators of Preschools/Child Care Programs<sup>4</sup>, Kindergarten Teachers<sup>5</sup>, Preschool Teachers<sup>6</sup>, and Child Care Workers<sup>7</sup>) for three out of four counties in this report – Boone, Stephenson, and Winnebago.

Although the specific occupational definitions differed from IDES descriptions and the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey descriptions, salaries were rather consistent with one another in that wages within IDES's preschool teacher and child care worker categories and the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey child care staff categories were within the same range; however, it should be noted that the IDES's definition of child care worker includes a provider working in either a center or family child care home which is differentiated by the *Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey*.

A preschool teacher in Winnebago County makes about \$4,000 more than a preschool teacher in Boone county.

Kindergarten teachers in Winnebago County make about \$15,000 more than that of a preschool teacher in the same county.

In Boone and Winnebago Counties, preschool teachers make more than child care workers.

# KEY POINTS FROM THE ILLINOIS SALARY & STAFFING SURVEY OF LICENSED CHILD CARE FACILITIES: FY 2023

The median full-time, full-year salary of child care staff range from \$24,440 for school-age workers to \$48,796 for director/teachers.

Teachers, 55.5% of whom have an associate's degree or higher, have a median annual salary of approximately \$31,369.

Half of surveyed family child care practitioners net \$15,000 or less annually.
