The median annual salaries of all child care providers in this report are significantly below the median earnings of persons living and working in each county.¹ While individuals serving in administrative capacities in child care centers are most likely to receive wages barely above the county's median wage (between\$35,360 and \$39,113 for director/teachers and administrative directors), the majority of child care center teachers (\$31,200) and family child care providers (\$30,000) are earning well below the median wage for employed persons in their county with child care center assistant teachers (\$27,040) earning the least. When it comes to insurance and pension benefits, 2 in 5child care center staff members are provided partial or full coverage by their employer and all staff receive paid sick leave.



### The Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) reported median

yearly wages for 2022 for four early care and education occupations (Educational Administrators of Preschools/Child Care Programs<sup>4</sup>, Kindergarten Teachers<sup>5</sup>, Preschool Teachers<sup>6</sup>, and Child Care Workers<sup>7</sup>) in two of the twelve counties in this report— Effingham and Jefferson.

Although the specific occupational definitions differed from IDES descriptions and the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey descriptions, salaries were rather consistent with one another in that wages within IDES's preschool teacher and child care worker categories and the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey child care staff categories were within the same range; however, it should be noted that the IDES's definition of child care worker includes a provider working in either a center or family child care home which is differentiated by the *Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey*.

Kindergarten teachers in Jefferson County make more than double that of child care workers in the same county.

The median full-time, full-year salary of child care staff range from \$27,040 for assistant teachers to \$39,113 for administrative directors.

Teachers, 61.3% of whom have an associate's degree or higher, have a median annual salary of approximately \$29,120.

Over half (53.3%) of family child care practitioners net \$20,240 or less annually.
