The median annual salaries of all child care providers in this report are

assistants (\$31,200) earning the least. When it comes to insurance and pension benefits, about half of child care center staff members are provided partial or full coverage by their employer.



# The Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) reported median

yearly wages for 2022 for four early care and education occupations (Educational Administrators of Preschools/Child Care Programs<sup>4</sup>, Kindergarten Teachers<sup>5</sup>, Preschool Teachers<sup>6</sup>, and Child Care Workers<sup>7</sup>) in Cook County.

Although the specific occupational definitions differed from IDES descriptions and the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey descriptions, salaries were rather consistent with one another in that wages within IDES's preschool teacher and child care worker categories and the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey child care staff categories were within the same range; however, it should be noted that the IDES's definition of child care worker includes a provider working in either a center or family child care home which is differentiated by the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey.

Teachers, 65.5% of whom have an associate's degree or higher, have a median annual salary of approximately \$34,580.

Over half (54.4%) of surveyed family child care practitioners net \$20,000 or less annually.
