The median annual salaries of all child care providers in this report are significantly below the median earnings of persons living and working in each county with the exception of McDonough County.¹ While individuals serving in administrative capacities in child care centers are most likely to receive wages above the county's median wage (between \$37,066 and \$39,728 for director/teachers and administrative directors), the majority of family child care providers (\$35,360) and child care center teachers (\$31,200) are earning well below the median wage for employed persons in their county, with child care center teacher assistants (\$27,040) earning the least. When it comes to insurance benefits, less than one out of every five child care center staff members are provided partial or full coverage by their employer. Over half receive paid sick leave and pension/retirement.




The Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) reported median

yearly wages for 2022 for four early care and education occupations (Educational Administrators of Preschools/Child Care Programs⁴, Kindergarten Teachers⁵, Preschool Teachers⁶, and Child Care Workers⁷) in five of the seven counties in this report - Henry, Knox, McDonough, Rock Island, and Warren.

Although the specific occupational definitions differed from IDES descriptions and the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey descriptions, salaries were rather consistent with one another in that wages within IDES's preschool teacher and child care worker categories and the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey child care staff categories were within the same range; however, it should be noted that the IDES's definition of child care worker includes a provider working in either a center or family child care home which is differentiated by the Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey.


MEDIAN YEARLY WAGES / 2022

The median full-time, full-year salary of child care staff range from \$23,920 for school-age workers to \$39,728 for administrative directors.

Teachers, 51.6% of whom have an associate's degree or higher, have a median annual salary of approximately \$30,160.

Over half (52%) of surveyed family child care practitioners net \$22,800 or less annually.
